Communications

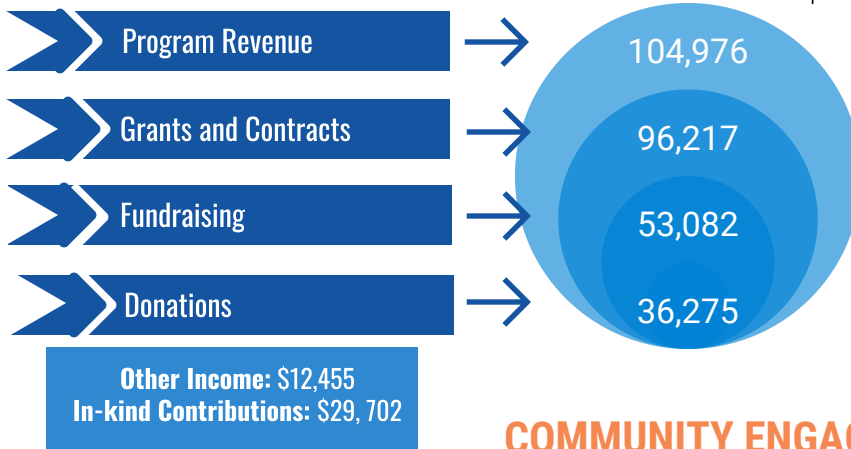


Provided **12** monthly e-newsletters with a reach of **1825** per month. **1** semi-annual newsletter provided in Spanish, English, and Korean.
